Whenever someone challenges the Bible, I always remember that I am faced with the choice of trading my faith in the Bible for faith in the man who is critical of it. I have never met a man, or heard a man, or read the work of a man who I would rather trust than the Bible. Who or what do you trust for your final authority?

Read your Bible, pray every day, and you'll grow and grow (Hebrews 4:12,13).

We've thrown in a few pictures of some of the people we've met and someday we'll tell you the lessons we've learned. As we live and move about, let's remember Paul's admonishment to Timothy, "Be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry." And when it's time to pray, remember one of the shortest prayers recorded in the Bible is, "Lord save me."
